

VITIVINÍCOLA CHODIN PARAM

Paula Chodin Param and Arnaldo Batista are Vitivinícola Chodin Param, a young winemaking project in the Itata and Bío Bío valleys. Working with local small farmers, their goal is to help preserve the area's ancient vineyards, assist in transitioning to organic and regenerative agriculture, and make wines that honor the incredible viticultural heritage of central Chile.

2022 was a very good vintage in Itata and Bío Bío, with moderate temperatures, good rainfall, and generous quantities of fruit. Paula's wines are simultaneously fruit forward and well structured.



Chodin Param Buscame Adentro 2022

100% País from centenarian vines deep in the forest near Nacimiento in the Bío Bío Valley. Destemmed, fermented on the skins in plastic bins and aged in stainless steel. Small addition of SO2 at bottling.

Chodin Param Parra Libre Cinsault 2022

100% País from centenarian vines near Coelemu in Itata. Destemmed, fermented on the skins in plastic bins, and aged in stainless steel. Small addition of SO2 at bottling.
